You will be interested in knowing that the committee passed a motion adopting this report as a guide to the committee in dealing with such cases.

In addition to the above, the following motion was adopted -- "In all cases involving homosexuality of students, the Conduct Committee will consider for re-admission only those students who have taken treatment through the Student Health Clinic and are recommended for re-admission thereby". It is my understanding that the committee has followed this policy in the past, but it seemed desirable in discussing these cases, particularly, to have a written motion of this sort in the committee file.
